 - APPL- Lesa – test scores – 3rd grade classes, had speaking test and students are all above grade level!!! Proud of our third grade teachers. Ms. Briz was so excited! 4th grade have to do writing, listening and speaking – had 11/51 not proficient. We know who they are and have a plan. For the listening, the hardest part of the test – had 9/26 not proficient, Reading had 3/51 not proficient, 48/51 proficient. Plan in place for those who did not make it. 5th grade – 1 class beat national and district average. Had all kids that were proficient or above on speaking and writing. (the 1 was virtual) The other class had some technical problems – the mask was causing the the kids speaking to not work right. Teacher listening and giving the kids feedback.
 - New Literacy program for Spanish – Benchmark Adalante – statewide. Bernal – topics and stories have changed, the stories are interesting and connected to the science they are learning, there is more non-fiction, and there are nice pictures, some of material local and so its easier and more exciting for them to learn. Kids excited about it and loving science. Have their own work book to write and take notes. Have more on-line resources, and interactive white boards.
 - WIDA- Susan R. – ESL test to see how proficient they are coming. The school won an award for the growth of ESL students.
- **Safety- Eliza- Covid procedures we are doing – (whole school came in 1/3 lower, so happy to see how they are doing because last year were not able to.)**
 - Any safety concerns? Parents crossing the street in front of the school, sidewalk cracks will be improved by district. 2 kids went to the park instead of coming to school, the absent call went out at 10:30. Susan worked on it and now absent calls will be going out now at 8:30. Camera’s up and going and on-line and helping solve a lot of issues.
