- 1. Welcome- Mrs. Maravilla
 - Talked about principals meeting earlier today about corona virus. School will still be happening unless other notice.
 - Quickly talked about student achievement in language arts, math, and computer programs. Student are showing improvement in most areas. Admin watches WIN group results. They monitor by class and work with teachers. They use manipulatives.
 - Construction Update- There will be a nurses office, everyone will be in the office instead of scattered around the school in different places, administration will be taking video of how to drop off and pick up during spring break.
- 2. Mrs. Harrah talked about Turn- around school. Interviews of parents and teachers will happen. They will come in and find around 12 problems and the school will pick 3-4 goals to work on. Mrs. Harrah thinks that in house professional development would be better because things could be monitored daily instead of intermittently.
- 3. Rise Modules (Practice Rise Test)
 - 3rd graders don't do as well. 4th and 5th grade seem to do better.
- 4. Take Home Library will go out daily. Beckie Basso requested more non-fiction books be included.
- 5. Summer School- This will use title money. Teachers have invited 5 students. (20 per grade level) Spanish summer school will be taught by Mrs. Fabian and she has invited students.
- 6. Raz Kids (\$1,500) will be funded by title money next year.
- 7. There are 58 Kinder students moving onto dual immersion classes next year.
- 8. Talked about Budget for next year. Budget was approved as shown below.
- Jill Hunt motioned to approve budget as shown. Brooke Neumann second. All in attendance in favor of the proposed budget.
